(a) In this section, "sexual abuse" has the meaning stated in § 5–701 of the Family
Law Article.

17 (b) An action for damages arising out of an alleged incident or incidents of sexual 18 abuse that occurred while the victim was a minor shall be filed within [7] **20** years of the 19 date that the victim attains the age of majority.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect any cause of action arising on or after October 1, 2009.
