New York State is one of the very worst in all of America for how it treats victims of child sexual abuse.

The root of the problem is our archaic statute of limitations (SOL) for these crimes.

The Child Victims Act would change that by completely removing the criminal and civil SOLs and create a one-year civil window to provide justice for older victims and expose pedophiles who have been hidden and continue to prey on other children..
